# What is Africa Information Highway

- The Africa Information Highway (AIH) is the AfDB's initiative that has linked the African countries through the Open Data Platform
- This initiative covers data management and data dissemination tools
- The system facilitates data exchange in SDMX

# AIH Components

- Each country got an Open Data Platform (ODP) that allows to disseminate their Statistical Data
- An Executive Mobile Monitor is also available to disseminate data on mobile devices
- A SDGs Data hub is available with possibility to generate SDGs reports across Africa
- A SDG page is also available for each country on top of ODP
- A Census Data Page ready to use on ODP

# AIH Implementation

The installation start in January 2013 and the system is now available in:

- All 54 Africans countries
- 9 regional and sub regional organizations
- Around 17 Central Bank and Ministries of finance(through the IMF/AfDB collaboration
- Some others ministries like Ministries of transports, labor in zambia

- Improve data harmonization, thereby increase data comparability.
- Improve exchanges of data among organizations and countries.

# Systems functionalities

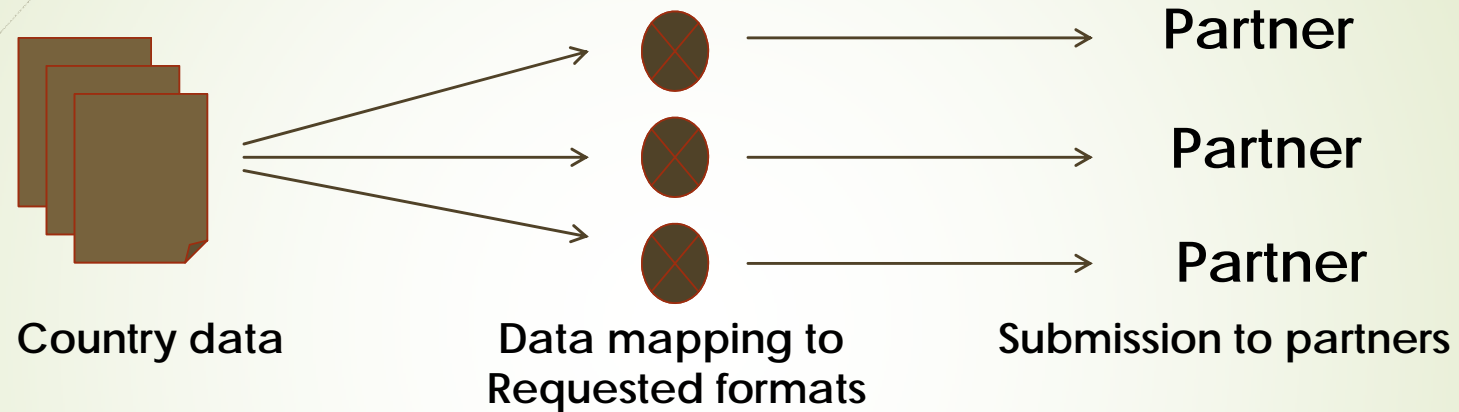
- Users can access a wide range of development data on African countries from different sources.

## Current process

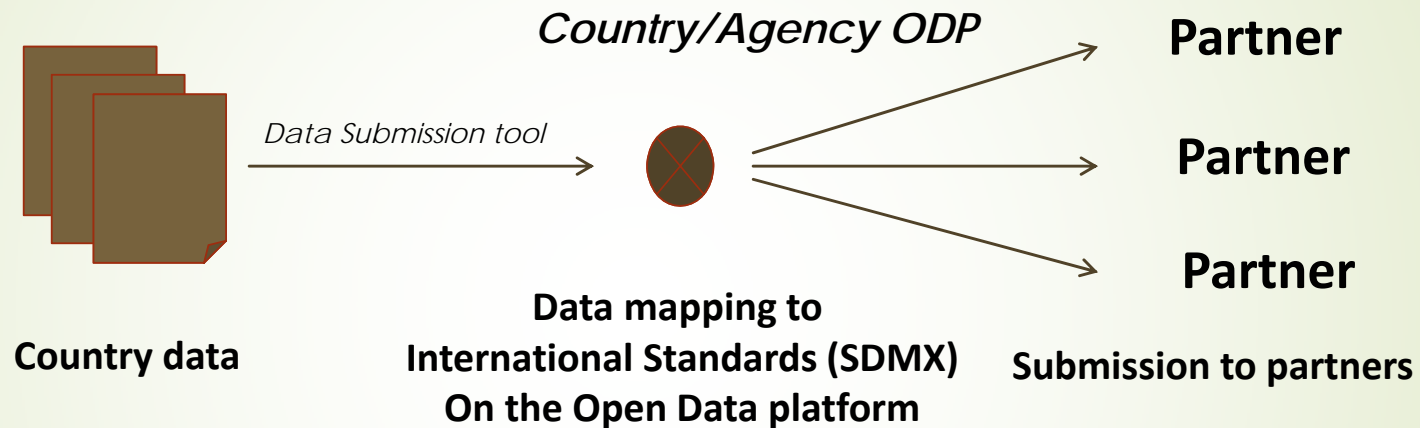
- Organization specific data mapping and formats leading to repetitive work

## To-be process

- Countries map data to international standards (SDMX) and load in the AfDB's Open Data platform
- Data collecting organizations pick from the Open Data platform .

# AfDB and IMF collaboration

- IMF is collaborating with AfDB to implement eGDDS in Africa using the AfDB platforms
- Around 17 countries are already covered for this collaboration
- Using the country Open Data platform, IMF implement the National Summary Data Page (NSDP) which all data domain covered by this eGDDS initiative.
- As the portals are SDMX compliant, IMF use the portals to collect automatically in SDMX format data from African countries which participated of the eGDDS
- Through this collaboration we expect to push and assist countries to upgrade to SDDS. Country like Senegal has objective to join this SDDS initiative in 2017
- So this will be an important result for this successful with the two institutions
- AfDB expect also to have others international organizations joining this initiative
