German exonyms for geographical features in Slovakia

Submitted by Austria**

Summary **

In response to a request from the Geodesy, Cartography, and Cadastre Authority of the Slovak Republic (Úrad geodézie, kartografie a katastra SR), the StAGN has compiled a list of German exonyms for geographical features in Slovakia. This compilation includes 179 toponyms. Each name is classified and assigned to one of the following five types:

- **Standardized** German name form
- **Historical** name form
- **Regionally** restricted usage of the name
- **Inappropriate** name (use must be avoided)
- **Endonym** for cross-border features

German exonyms for geographical features in Slovakia

The Permanent Committee on Geographical Names (StAGN) has been asked by the Geodesy, Cartography, and Cadastre Authority of the Slovak Republic (Úrad geodézie, kartografie a katastra SR) to compile a list of selected German exonyms for the most important geographical features in Slovakia. As Slovakia was home to a number of settlement areas with a German-speaking population prior to 1945, many of its geographical locations bear German names. Many of these names are historically significant, but are no longer used today. The list comprises 179 toponyms, which are assigned to one of the following four categories based on their status:

- *historical*: exonym not in use any more,
- *standardized*: exonyms in common use with a standardized spelling,
- *regional*: exonyms used only in some parts of Austria,
- *inappropriate*: exonyms which should not be used in any publication.

Additionally, the list includes some endonyms for border crossing features, which are identified as such.

It must be noted that there exist many more historical exonyms that can be found in old maps and older publications. The spelling of these names may vary according to different sources.
